
Reserved entries close *Wednesday*, *Jan. 19, 2011*. Walk-ins are accepted if lanes are available and complete fees are paid in cash.

The files and news articles that Dan Gilluly collected on local bowlers and how the articles were put together makes very interesting reading.

Such as, the first father and son combination to roll 300 games were William Rusch Sr. rolled his 300 on March 29, 1911. Sixteen years later, his son William Jr., rolled his 300 on February 10, 1928.


Larry Jackson rolled his first 300 on March 24, 1971 at Mt. Pleasant Lanes. On August 28, 1988, Troy joined his father in the 300 circle when he rolled his first at Starlite Lanes.

Joining the 300 circle of father and sons are Danny Thimmes who rolled a 300 on February 14, 1994 and his father Ed Thimmes who has rolled numerous 300's but his first was February 2, 1972.

Another father and son combo and record is held by Doug Sigler who rolled his 300 on January 3, 1971 at Tiki Lanes and his son Mike turned in his first perfect game on April 16, 1981 at Scenic Lanes in Logan.

While it isn't a record, Tom Taylor had the unique distinction of striking for two 300's in the same league, Monday Night All Star League, during the same season.
