Open Championship Tournament continue:

All Events Handicap champion was Jay pierce, who has returned to bowling with a vengeance. Jay rolled 613 in his doubles, 584 in the singles and 570 for his team event. With his handicap his score was 2355. Karen Morris took the second spot with 2293.

John Bossone captured the All Events Actual win with 2189. In the doubles John had 673, singles 694 and the team event 736. Karen Morris again was second with 2176.



Women's Championship results:

The Friends team of Darlene Travis, Diana Knight, Billie Cotton, Midge Rahm and Joy Kellenbarger took the top honor in both divisions in the Team Events with 3647 w/hdcp and an actual score of 2869 for the actual title. This is the second year that Darlene, Diana and Joy have been on the actual winning team.

Karen Morris and Joy Kellenbarger won the Doubles Handicap with 1449 and took the Actual Doubles with 1285. Erica Kellenbarger and Joy Kellenbarger were second in both divisions with 1435 in the Handicap Division and 1214 in the Actual Division.

Joy Kellenbarger holds 1st place in the Singles Handicap Event with a total of 738. On the last squad of the tournament Jennifer Klein almost caught Kellenbarger when she rolled a score of 732 w/hdcp.
