To all League Presidents: This season there is a new rule as to where the league bank statement is to be sent. It must go to the President. The President must verify it with the records of the Treasurer to be sure the money is correct and being deposited within the 7 day time frame. Two signatures are still required on all accounts.

Don't forget to get your prize list committee set and have your league vote on this by the 5th week of your league.
