JOHN (STEVE) RUCKMAN – PIONEER SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE

Steve bowled many years in the surrounding area bowling alleys. He bowled his high game of 299 and high series of 764 in the Starlite Classic League at Starlite Lanes. Steve has also bowled in many City Tournaments and finished in 1st place in 1985 for actual of 719 and handicap of 743. He also placed in the top 10 for "All Events" in the City tournaments, during his career. He bowled in the All Star League and Classic League to name of few and his highest average carried, was a 204. He concluded his bowling career in 2005 at Starlite Lanes and carried a 173 average in the Baltimore Businessmen #2 league.

In the 1970's he was instrumental in starting a bowling league for teens and older people, who are handicapped. He volunteers as a bowling coach for all his friends over the years. One of his highlights was taking teams of bowlers to the Special Olympics at The Ohio State University. They had a great time and came back with medals, which they were proud of. He also enjoys being part of the parties they have throughout the year. Even after 42 years this bowling league still meets every Saturday morning and he is still there coaching!

Regina has been bowling over 50 years, sometimes two or three times a week.
