SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE – Erica Kellenbarger

Erica has bowled in the Inter-City tournaments and has been and currently is, part of the Women Champion team along with, part of four teams that still hold records. She is actively bowling Tournaments in Ohio and around the Nation. Erica is also involved with holding office for State 700, Local 600 and various leagues. She bowled her high series of 843, which was 2nd highest in the State for 2010 – 2011, and it is still the record for SEOH Association. Her latest involvement in bowling began in 2014, when she started working with Logan High School bowling Team. She has a lot of experience and dedication to help youth get involved and improve their game.
