He has been involved in many committees while a Director in the LBA and was the All Star President, as well. Ron has bowled in various leagues at Starlite and Tiki Lanes along with bowling with Ohio Air Guard in Columbus. He has on the lane accomplishments such as a 299 game, 11 in a row and both times, shot well over 700 series. He was Actual & Handicap All Events winner in the Lancaster City Tournament in 1992, 700 Club Tournament Champion in 1994 and 1997. Ron has bowled in the USBC Open Championship Tournaments. While bowling in the Lancaster All Star League in 2004-2005, he led the season 200 game average 82 out of 102 games or 84%. Daniel also led the 600 series average with 28 out of 31 sets or 90%.
