The age for entering this year will be 50 years old. There is a division for men and a division for women.


The entries will be out at all centers. The cost is only \$14 and there are two divisions male and female.

### Bowling is a Family Sport! Just Ask Max Wildermuth!

Information for this article was gathered from Dan Gilluly's files, by Alice Snider, who has gathered information that is being used in this article.

This father and son team bowled together for over 17 years. The Burger Chef team consisted of Bernard, Sam, Tom, Max, Paul and Phil Wildermuth.

Bernard (father) began his bowling at the Lancaster Athletic Club Lanes. 20th Century Lanes opened. The father and son team moved there and started bowling in the Classic League. With the closing of 20th Century, they moved to Mt. Pleasant Lanes and bowled in the All Star League. They followed the All Star League to Tiki Lanes when Mt. Pleasant closed it's doors.

Dan's records have Max, Paul, Tom and Sam bowling in the All Star League in the early 1940's. They were members of that league in over 15 years. They were solid members of the team with their averages ranging from 180 plus to 200 during their entire bowling careers. They are also members of the Lancaster 700 Club with each having several 700 series. Tom can also claim a 300 game.

As time passes, we all eventually stop bowling and put away our balls and shoes. Bernard and Sam ended their bowling careers in 1982, Phil in 1973 and Paul 1986 and Tom in 1990.

Max continues to bowl in in the Thursday His N' Hers league at Tiki. He has averaged: 2011-12 194; 2012-13 186; 2013-14 189 and last season he averaged 161. His bowling career speaks for itself. Just a couple years ago, Max rolled a 279 game.

Max was honored last season with his induction into the SEOH USBC Bowling Hall of Fame for Superior Performance. Well deserved recognition of his long and eventful bowling career.

I called Max and chatted with him about his bowling career. Max said that there were just too many great memories to pick one or two. I was glad I had the chance to talk to him and hear some stories about "back then".

This is an example of what bowling is to so many of us. I personally hope to be bowling and enjoying the people when I reach this age. That would truly be a blessing.
