Because of the increased costs and changes from USBC the local dues have been raised to \$10.00. This is the first increase since the merger of the Lancaster Bowling Association and the Lancaster Women's Bowling Association back in 2005-06. Dues pay not only the association manager's salary but covers many things including office equipment, office supplies, tournament supplements, Pins Over Average Contest Prize awards, awards for association record scores, tournament supplements and much more. Bottom line is that dues will be \$20.00 this season. The board is working on a member benefits program. Details will follow when everything is finalized.

The board is working hard to continue the programs and striving to make the best choices to provide the best services for the association members.

<u>To all League Presidents</u>: Your league bank statement must be sent to you. The President must verify it with the records of the Treasurer to be sure the money is correct and being deposited within the 7 day time frame. Two signatures are required on all accounts. Each league is to have an Employer Identification Number.

Don't forget to have your prize list completed and approved by your league no later than 5th week of bowling.

<u>To all League Secretaries</u>: Be sure to get a membership card for each and every bowler. Cards are pre-printed for all of your returning league members. Remind bowlers that have moved, that they need to update their information. All new members and subs complete a card. Make sure that you can read their writing. *If you can't read it, I can't read it..* Give the receipt end of the card to *only* bowlers who pay dues in your league. The certification form, membership cards (alphabetically) and fees are sent to Joy Kellenbarger within 30 days of the start of your league.
