The event began with a welcome to all and announcements. All veterans were thanked for their service and were asked to come forward. There were 14 bowlers who were veterans in attendance. Each of the veterans shared which branch of the service and the years that they served. Each was given a hand-made thank you gift.



Place cards were given to everyone in attendance and each person wrote the name of a veteran who were important in their life. Everyone was asked to stand and SEOH USBC Board member and veteran Wendy Wyrick called the group to attention. After a moment of silence, Wyrick put the group at ease. This patriotic ceremony ended with the playing and singing of our National Anthem.
