## Bowlers to Veterans Link... Do you know what the BVL is and does?

This great organization was founded in 1942 as the Bowlers Victory Legion, by a group of concerned and caring bowlers who promised "We will not forget about the sacrifices made by America's service men and women." The name was changed in 1972 to the Bowlers to Veterans Link.

BVL is a national nonprofit charity (501(c) 3) which supports the neediest veterans. BVL responds to veterans in need - recuperating veterans, veterans suffering from Post Traumatic Stress Disorder and aging veterans - giving them an outlet for the joy, freedom and friendship that recreation and sport can bring. Bowlers to Veterans Link provides arts and crafts programs, music and sports activities, reading materials, board games and much more for recuperating veterans in all 172 VA hospitals.

A growing number of WWII veterans in their later years are suffering the often lonely days of long term care. Thanks to you and your donations to the BVL, these often forgotten heroes can enjoy billiards, cards and bingo. They spend their days fishing, bowling or gardening through programs at the State Veterans Homes throughout the country. The group Recreation performs for these veterans. They are amazing, uplifting, patriotic and inspiring to all.

The BVL is supported and guided by the bowling industry and the nation's league bowlers. More than 1,200 local bowling associations nationwide participate in the BVL fund-raising effort and coordinate local efforts.

The Bowlers to Veterans Link is America's only national sports organization specifically devoted to veterans with $80 \%$ of all money collected being used for the veterans, $13 \%$ for promotion and only $7 \%$ for the administration costs. BVL prides itself on one of the lowest overhead percentages. The commitment remains to insure that America's veterans are the recipients of the most funds possible.

Are you wondering what happens to the money we collect? The money, we collect, is donated to the BVL and is designated to help our local veterans. The monies collected will go to the Chillicothe VA Hospital. This in turn helps the Veterans in Lancaster and surrounding areas with whatever our local veterans need. [^0]:    Rules: 1. Each set of doubles will be assigned a pair of lanes. 2. Bowlers will rotate lanes. 3. Each frame the bowlers will throw their first ball if they do not throw a strike. If no strike, they decide which ball is the best and they record it on the score sheet. 4. The spare will be shot by the partner if neither bowler rolled a strike. This continues until the game is completed. This will continue for the following game. 5. The doubles with the highest two (2) game total including handicap will be the champions. 6. Bowlers with a $22-23$ avg of 21 games will use the highest 21 game avg. Bowlers with no average: Women will use 120 . Men will us 140 . 7. This is a fun fundraiser to honor our veterans, so everyone is required to have fun!
    $1^{\text {st }}$ place champs will receive an Award.
